A - The difficult words of Sha'ul (Paul) on the subjects of Law, Faith, and Grace. I will be addressing a handful of core statements that Sha'ul makes in the Brit HaChadashah that unfortunately today, are a root of contention among some. We'll be looking at his words in Colossians 2:8; Ephesians 2:14-21; Titus 1; 1 Timothy 4; Galatians 3:10; Galatians 4: 24-27; Galatians 5:1, Romans Chapters 2 and 7; 1 Corinthians 2 and other areas as we have the time. **This is an advanced and academic lecture series for those well read in the New Testament and are in the pursuit of advanced biblical truth.**

B - Torah Lessons from the ancient Land of Israel: In essence, the lectures are **Land of Israel on-location Torah studies**, essentially drawing people into learning Torah lessons on morality, justice, and righteousness from certain archaeological and biblical sites in Israel, which have very strong moral and spiritual lessons to teach us, exactly as the Word says, that *"all things are written for our instruction, reproof, correction and training in righteousness."* **This is a lecture on the lighter side of academic scholarship.**

C - Introduction to Hebraic Thought and Biblical Word Definitions in the Brit HaChadasha (New Testament). The "New Testament" is loaded with all kinds of ideas and concepts that are Hebraic to their very core. Without a working knowledge of those core issues in Hebraic language and culture, the concepts are too often muddled in Greek philosophy and thus difficult to understand from a Hebraic perspective. Trying to understand "Jesus" and "Paul" outside of their local cultural Hebraic contexts produces a number of problems for the interpreters of their words; problems that result in getting core doctrines twisted out of shape from what they were originally meant to convey. Definitions to be addressed: Righteousness, Faith, Grace, Law, Repentance, what the term "Mashiach" (Messiah) means, and other definitions as we have the time. **This is a lecture designed for "newbies" to Hebraic thought.**
